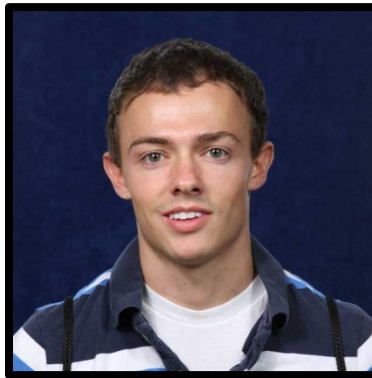


Medical Alumni Association Scholarship
